# BIOGRAPHIE



## LEA BARBIER :

Tap dance, washboard, chœurs, cymbale, tom.

## GREG GARGHENTINI :

Chant, guitare, grosse caisse, caisse claire, harmonica.

Their bond is an obvious kind of alchemy, born from their shared passion for music and their boldness in blending their worlds: rock and circus arts. One Rusty Band is an atypical and truly unique duo in the French music landscape. Léa is lively and versatile, dancing effortlessly over perfectly mastered tap dance rhythms. But that's not all. Everything seems so simple when you listen to them and yet everything is highly technical:

from Greg's controlled, cavernous voice to Léa's sparkling street-performer energy.

**When Greg launches into his guitar riffs, he unleashes a contagious energy while playing bass drum and snare with his feet. Léa, for her part, brings her own distinctive touch with her washboard, her acrobatics, and her tap dancing, which she plays as others would pound their drum kit. Together, they create a sound they describe as dirty blues rock, with tones somewhere between the White Stripes and Seasick Steve.**

Since 2016, they've been living this adventure of life on the road and on stage, moving from place to place and touring nonstop. With three albums and over 500 concerts to their name, they've played all across France, Europe, and even India.

They've made a name for themselves performing at festivals such as Cognac Blues Passion, Guitare en Scène, God Save The Kouign, as well as venues like Le Novomax, Le Club, and La Traverse, not to mention emblematic street-arts festivals such as Chassepierre in Belgium or Les Fondus du Macadam. They've also had the honor of opening for major artists including Jeff Beck, Kingfish Ingram, Les Wampas, Delgres, Ayron Jones and Laura Cox.

With their third album, *Line After Line* (released in June 2025), One Rusty Band shares their stories of travel and encounters, a work that resonates with heartfelt artistic universality.

True to their spirit of freedom, they composed, recorded, and arranged this new record in their home studio in Brittany, where they are currently based. Greg, drawing on his experience as a sound engineer, handled the mixing, while Léa designed the visual artwork. Together with their filmmaker

friend Louis Devaux, they worked on the music videos. Each song was recorded live in the studio to capture the raw energy of their performances. Mastering was entrusted to Alexis Bardinnet of Globe Audio, who has worked with artists such as Lofofora, Les Wampas, and Ibrahim Maalouf. Their live stage direction is crafted in collaboration with Kristell Arquetoux.

A beautiful human and musical adventure.

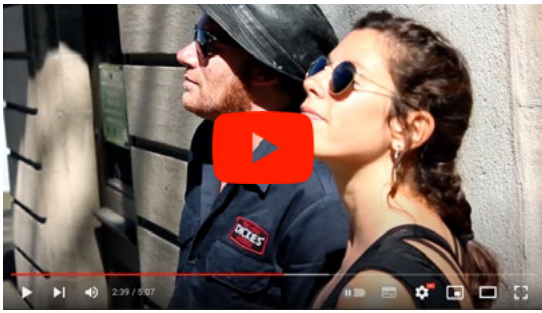
